

Turtuk is a located on the banks of the Shyok River. Turtuk was under Pakistan's control until 1971, after which India gained control of this strategic area. Geographically, Turtuk lies in the Baltistan Region and is one among four such villages in India, the other three being Tyakshi, Chalunkha and Thang. It is predominantly a Muslim village, and residents speak languages including Balti, Ladakhi and Urdu. Turtuk is the last outpost in India after which the Pakistancontrolled GilgitBaltistan begins. Turtuk is one of the gateways to the Siachen Glacier. Overnight stay at hotel in Diskit.
