

Kailash Mansarovar Yatra (10 DAYS TRIP)

Temples to Visit:

1. Bhageshwari Shakthi Peedam, Nepalgkanch, Nepal
2. Ravana Lake
3. Mansarovar Lake
4. Yamadwar (Temple of Lord Yama)
5. Dakshinamurthy (South-facing Shiva form)
6. South-west face of Kailash
7. West face of Kailash
8. North face of Kailash
9. Ponnar Maniyan Darshan (view of Kailash Mountain turning gold)
10. Dolmala Mountain (18,471 feet high)
11. Gauri Kund (Lake)
12. Three days of circumambulation around Mount Kailash (Parikrama)

Information about more than 108 places during the complete journey to Kailash.

DAY 1

- Around 6:00 Am Departure from Chennai Airport and other districts towards Lucknow and reaching time on or before 12:30 PM at Lucknow airport. Then, by innova Car we have to travel 170 kms towards Nepalkanch (Nepal). Then we will Visit Bageshwari Sakthi Peedam Temple in Nepalkanch which is one among 51 Sakthi Peedam in India. After Dharshan We have An Meeting in Hotel to Discuss about Kailash Yathirai. Night stay At Nepalkanch.

DAY 2

- At 5:30 in the morning, we depart from the hotel and head to the airport. From Nepalkanch Airport, we travel 200 km by a special, small aircraft to reach Simikot village. From Simikot village, we take a special helicopter to reach Hilsa village, located at the Nepal-China border Assistance for our Kailash Yathirai Meeting with the Chinese guide to receive suggestions. | Staying in a mud house in Hilsa after dinner.

DAY 3

- In the morning, after completing the immigration process of Nepal, crossing the iron bridge over the Karnali River to reach the Chinese border. Completion of the immigration process at the Chinese border. Departure from the Chinese border by special bus to reach Taklakot city. In the city of Thaklakot, staying in a way that

our body can withstand the cold and purchasing oxygen cylinders. After dinner, staying at a hotel in Thaklakot.

DAY 4

- Departing in the morning by bus from Taklakot city to visit Lake Ravan. Reaching Lake Manasarovar to take a holy bath and perform special rituals. Circumambulating Lake Manasarovar by special bus and collecting the holy water of Manasarovar. Visiting Mount Kailash from Manasarovar. After that, departing from here to reach the town of Tarson. After dinner, staying at a hotel in Tarson town, or spending the night in a mud house on the banks of Manasarovar.

DAY 5

- In the morning, we departed from Darsan City by bus and reached Yamadhuwari, where we visit the temple of Eman. Today's pilgrimage covered a total distance of 12 km. Those who cannot walk can take a horse from here at their own expense. Visiting the western face of Kailash.

DAY 6

- In the early morning, as the sun rises, we are witnessing the 'Golden Lord' shimmering like a golden idol on the Kailash Mountain under the sun's rays. (This event is relevant to today's weather conditions.) Today's circumambulation consists of a total of 22 km of a challenging journey. Along the way, we will visit Ganapati Lake and, from a distance, glimpse Kuber Lake. In this Kailash journey, we will traverse the very difficult region of Dol Mala Mountain (18,471 feet high) either by walking or on horseback. Parvati Devi is considered a place where one bathes daily, known as Kaurikund. We are visiting the lake. After visiting the place where Milakarpah lived, we will stay in Sudulbuk, facing east of Kailash, after dinner.

DAY 7

- In the morning, we are having darshan facing the eastern direction of Kailash from Sudulpuk (unable to see Mount Kailash). Today's circumambulation covers a total of 7 km, which is an easy journey. Later, we bow towards the southern direction of Kailash and complete our Kailash circumambulation. After departing by special bus and having lunch, we leave from the base area of Kailash, the town of Darshan, and reach the town of Taklakot. We are shopping for souvenirs/items to gift our relatives or friends in Darchan or Taklakot. After dinner, staying in Taklakot.

DAY 8

- In the morning, we depart from Thirupukil by a special bus and reach the China-Nepal border. Completing the immigration procedures of China at the Chinese border. Crossing into Nepal via the iron bridge over the Karnali River. Completion of immigration procedures in Nepal. After dinner, staying in a mud house in the village of Hilsa.

DAY 9

- After breakfast, we leave the mud house in Hilsa and arrive at the helicopter landing site. Traveling by special helicopter from the village of Hilsa, which is on the Nepal-China border, we reach the village of Simikot. From the airport in Simikot, we travel 200 km by a special small aircraft and arrive at Nepalkanch city. If there is time - visiting the Bhagwati Devi temple, one of the 51 Shakti Peethas in Nepalkanch. After dinner, staying at the Nepalganj hotel.

DAY 10

- After breakfast, departing from the Nepalkanch hotel towards the city of Lucknow. From the major city of Nep Nepalkanch algunj in Nepal, we travel 170 km by bus or van to reach Lucknow Airport. Departing by flight from Lucknow Airport, We will arrive in Chennai that evening. With sweet memories of the Kailash pilgrimage, we are departing towards our respective homes. We are receiving the 'Kailash Yatra Completion Certificate' and the title 'Kailash Mani' for completing the Kailash Yatra.

Important Rules

1. A passport is mandatory.
2. Travellers must be under 70 years of age.
3. Both males and females can participate in this journey.
4. It is good to engage in daily walking exercises of 3 to 5 km.
5. Those with asthma or who have undergone heart surgery should consult their family doctors.
6. Since the trip involves going to a cold region, travellers must bring sweaters, shawls, gloves, and medications.
7. The travel organizer has the right to modify the travel plan.
8. Subject to the regulations of India, Nepal, and China.
9. Please read the rules carefully.

Travel Payment Procedure

1. You must decide on the travel date and pay Rs.10, 000 (non-refundable) at the time of booking.
2. You must pay Rs.1, 00,000 at least 30 days before the travel date.
